ADULT 4-H AWARDS

Friend of 4-H - Two awarded plaques; one should be presently a 4-H leader and the other one to a business, organization or person. The Friend of 4-H Award is designed to honor individuals who have made contributions to 4-H on a countywide basis. These contributions to 4-H may be in the form of personal service, leadership, special training, publicity or financial support. The individual, business or organization should have a meaningful involvement in 4-H, is committed to the philosophy of 4-H Youth Development and have demonstrated high personal standards.

4-H Alumni Award - One awarded alumni pin; must have been a 4-H member anywhere in Wisconsin or the United States. May have remained active in 4-H by becoming a leader and sharing skills with youth

The 4-H alumni Award is designed to honor previous 4-H members who have distinguished themselves as adults. They should have made significant contributions to his/her choice vocation and/or significant voluntary contributions to the local community and beyond. (These contributions are not restricted to 4-H.)

Guidelines for nomination are as follows:

1. Friend of 4-H and 4-H Alumni Award
 - a. Nominees do not have to be 4-H leaders now.
 - b. Nominees should be active community members.
This could include 4-H.
 - c. 4-H alumni nominees must have been 4-H members.
 - d. Friend of 4-H nominees may be a person or organization who has supported 4-H by providing financial help, special training programs, publicity, etc.
